20-Nov-25	<p>Delhi, Delhi Highlights Tour</p> <p>After breakfast, explore Old Delhi, visiting Jama Masjid, enjoying a rickshaw ride in Chandni Chowk, and driving past the Red Fort.</p> <p>In the afternoon, visit New Delhi, including Qutab Minar and Humayun's Tomb. Stop for photos at India Gate, then drive past President's House, Parliament House, and Government Secretariat Buildings.</p>
21-Nov-25	<p>Agra, Agra Fort</p> <p>Discover the grandeur of Agra Fort, a masterpiece of Mughal architecture. Explore its stunning palaces, including Anguri Bagh, the Golden Pavilions, Khas Mahal, and the iconic Diwan-I-Khas and Diwan-I-Am, which once hosted royal audiences. A visit here is a journey through history and elegance.</p>
22-Nov-25	<p>Agra, Taj Mahal</p> <p>Experience the magic of the Taj Mahal at sunrise, a timeless tribute to love and one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Situated on the banks of the Yamuna, this iconic mausoleum was built by Mughal emperor Shah Jahan for his beloved consort Mumtaz Mahal. Its construction, which began in 1631, took 17 years to complete, leaving behind a masterpiece of eternal beauty.</p>
22-Nov-25	<p>Fatehpur Sikri, Fatehpur Sikri</p> <p>Explore Fatehpur Sikri, the historic city built by Emperor Akbar in 1569 and abandoned 15 years later due to water scarcity. Marvel at its elegant structures, including the Jama Masjid, the Tomb of Chishti, Panch Mahal, and other stunning palaces that showcase Mughal architectural brilliance.</p>
23-Nov-25	<p>Jaipur , Amber Fort &amp; City Palace</p> <p>A full-day exploration of Jaipur unveils its vibrant cultural and architectural legacy. After breakfast, we set off for an excursion to the majestic Amber Fort, the ancient capital of the state until 1728. Perched on a hilltop, this stunning sandstone fort offers breathtaking views and fascinating sites like the Jagmandir (Hall of Victory) glittering with mirrors, Jai Mahal, and the Temple of Kali.</p> <p>In the afternoon, we delve into the heart of Jaipur to visit the City Palace, a splendid fusion of Rajasthani and Mughal architecture. This grand palace complex, built between 1729 and 1732 by Sawai Jai Singh II and enhanced by successive rulers, boasts vast courtyards, lush gardens, and impressive buildings.</p> <p>We also explore the intriguing 18th-century Jantar Mantar Observatory, renowned for its architectural instruments, and admire the iconic latticed façade of the Hawa Mahal, or Palace of Winds. Jaipur truly epitomizes the charm and splendor of India's cultural heritage!</p>
25-Nov-25	<p>Mumbai, Elephant Caves</p> <p>Take a scenic one-hour boat ride from the Gateway of India to Elephanta Island, located 9 km off Mumbai's coast. Once the capital of a coastal kingdom and later named by the Portuguese after discovering a monolithic stone elephant, the island is now a UNESCO World Heritage site. Explore its 7th-century rock-cut cave temples, adorned with exquisite carvings of Lord Shiva and other Hindu deities, alongside shrines, courtyards, and grand halls that reflect the brilliance of ancient Indian architecture.</p>

25-Nov-25	<p>Mumbai, Mumbai City Tour</p> <p>Explore Mumbai with a half-day tour visiting the Prince of Wales Museum, a gothic structure built in 1905; Dhobi Ghat, an open-air laundry where thousands of washermen work; Mani Bhavan, Mahatma Gandhi's former residence with a library and memorabilia; and the iconic Gateway of India, perfect for a memorable group photo. Enjoy the rich history and culture of the city!</p>
